Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Niles Adult Education. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

We continually update our learning materials and strategies to meet the standards of the current High School Equivalency exam and emphasize 21st-century problem skills such as critical thinking, problem-solving, and evidence-based argumentation. We continue to develop career pathway programming in collaboration with Michigan Works, local Community Colleges, and employers.

# **PUPIL ASSIGNMENT**

Niles Adult Education is an alternative education program. Each semester Niles Senior High School and Niles New Tech review their rosters for students who are no longer able to graduate on time from those schools. Placement in an alternative secondary program such as Niles Adult Education is discussed with the students and parents/guardians as a means to better support the student's ability to graduate on time.
