Options & Expectations

Graduation Requirements

- Credits: minimum 26 earned of 28 offered
- Michigan Merit Curriculum = 18 specific credits of the 26
 - o English 9-12
 - Math: Geometry, Algebra 1, Algebra 2, final year math
 - Social Studies: US History, Civics, Economics, World History
 - Science:
 - Pathway A: Biology, Physical Science, Earth Science
 - Pathway B: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Earth Science
 - 2 credits of same Foreign Language
 - Visual, performing, applied arts 1 credit
 - PE (½) and Health (½)

Board Scholar

- 4 Years of *progressively* RIGOROUS coursework in all of the following:
 - Science
 - o English
 - Math: Pre-Calc or college course as 4th math
 - Social Studies: additional need beyond MMC
- 2 Years of the SAME foreign language
- Cumulative GPA: 3.0 or higher after 1st semester of senior year
- Minimum Test Score: 21 ACT or 1000 SAT
- These expectations are above & beyond the graduation requirements

Advanced Placement

- Advanced Placement Courses: pre-reqs and min test score on PSAT/SAT
 - Expect: RIGOR, summer work
 - Weighted grades
 - Can earn college credit by taking the test and achieving a certain score, set by the college.
 - 1st: US History(alternates with Government and Politics)
 - 2nd: Psychology
 - 3rd: English Language and Composition, recommended for 11th
 - 4th: Studio Art 2D Design, 3-D and Drawing
 - 5th: Biology was online for 2021-22
 - 6th: Calculus
 - 7th: English Literature and Composition, recommended for 12th

 - WritePlacer: 5 and Next Generation Math: 230
 - High School GPA incoming Sophomores 2.5 or higher meet English and Reading

Dual Enrollment

Three Dual Enrollment Opportunities:

- Early Middle College through Berrien RESA, generally only through LMC, application required, generally due in early February
- Early College Academy through LMC, application due March 15, 2022
- General dual enrollment, apply directly to LMC or SMC

Overview of Dual Enrollment

- core college courses (English, math, science and social studies/history) are weighted.
- Must have a "full" schedule; one period max for transportation
- NHS Counselors/staff do not directly register for dual enrollment courses.
 - Counselors do need registration sheets to review, approve, sign, and then send to the college.
 - Registration sheets must be to counselors by Friday, June 10th to participate in dual enrollment for the Fall of 2022.

Dual Enrollment

Overview of Dual Enrollment, continued

- Students are responsible for knowing NHS class times. College courses have to work around classes at NHS.
- Students & parents sign the DE contract that explains expectations, such as paying back the school for Ws or Fs; Ws at college are Fs at NHS, etc
- Students have accounts to monitor grades through LMC or SMC.
 - NHS does not have access to college grades and parents will not receive a username or password as they do with PowerSchool.

Elective Core Options: On Campus

• English

- College Writing (½ cr) 12th grade
- Creative Writing (½ cr) 12th grade
- AP English Language & Composition
 - Recommended for 11th grade
- AP English Literature & Composition
 - Recommended for 12th grade

Social Studies

- Psychology (½ cr): 11 and 12 only
- \circ Sociology ($\frac{1}{2}$ cr): 11 and 12 only
- AP US Government & Politics, every other year rotation
 - Fall 2023
- AP US History, every other year rotation
 - Fall 2022

Math

- Probability & Statistics
- Personal Finance
- Pre-Calculus
- AP Calculus
 - prereq of Pre-Calc

Science

- Chemistry
- Physics
- AP Biology (online 2021-22)
 - Prereq of Biology
- Foreign Language: 1 year required
 - Spanish 1-4
 - 2 years recommended for college bound and needed for Board Scholar status

Elective Options (non CTE)

- Fine Arts: 2nd art credit can waive 2nd year of Foreign Language
 - Art 1/2 (semester or year)
 - Advanced Art 3
 - can waive 2nd year of ForeignLanguage MMC requirement
 - o Choir
 - Counterpoints (audition required)
 - Symphonic Band
 - Jazz Band
 - Must also have Symphonic Band

Other:

- PE (semester or year)
 - Waivers: 2 years of Band or <u>student</u> <u>requested</u> "Organized Sports Credit" from Mrs. Smuda after a season of a sport
- Cadet: office, teacher, library 12th grade only
- Online: various options, Michigan Virtual High School
- Peer to Peer Mentoring: 11 and 12 only
- School to Career: Limited to 3 periods; 12th grade only; employment must match EDP career plans on Xello, application required and due the spring of your junior year. See Mrs. George.

Elective Options: Career Tech Ed

- On-Campus Electives: CTE
 - Ag Tech (1 period)
 - Agriculture & Natural Resources (2 periods): College Credit available through MSU
 - Auto Tech (1 period)
 - Automotive Technology (2 periods): ASE Certifications
 - Culinary Arts (2 periods): ServSafe and Manager Certification
 - Graphic Tech (1 period)
 - Graphic Arts (2 periods): LMC credit available, must take Graphic Tech first
 - Introduction to Business (1 period)
 - Introduction to Marketing (1 period)
 - School to Career (1-3 periods) 12 grade only. Application required by the Spring of Junior year.


